**A:** Despite the challenges, we are still **A**chieving the set goals

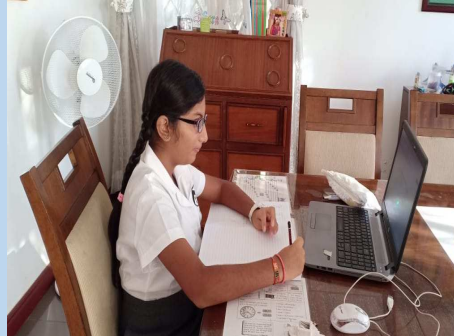
**R:** We have to remain **R**espectful in our interactions

- ❖ Welcomed others' feedback in order to learn

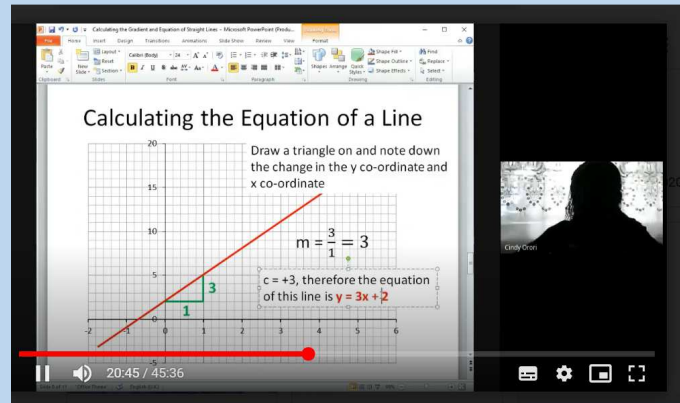
The Remote Teaching and Learning lessons have been well attended with near 100% turn out across the school. The sampled pictures below confirm how BKIS was taken into homes.

This is a screen shot of the page where we were working on together:

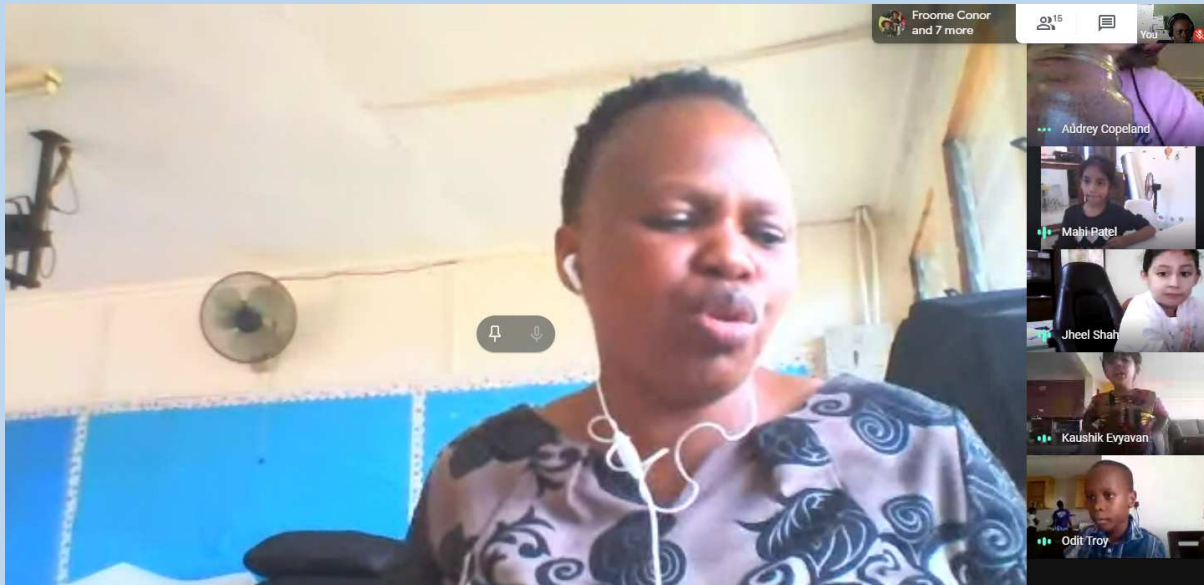

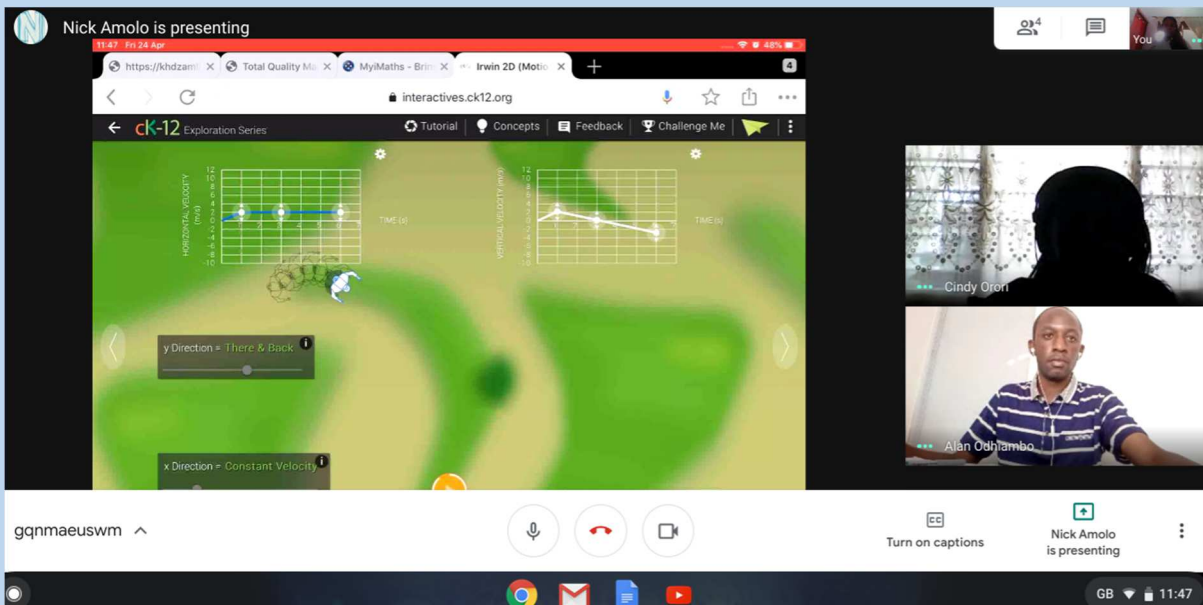
